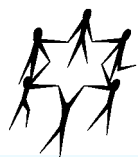

(Sundays 9 AM-12 Noon).

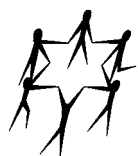

### Grades K-5

Students begin their Sunday mornings with Tefillah (prayer) and song with their peers. Families are welcome to join our students during this time. During religious school classes, students are taught both Judaics and Hebrew at a level that is appropriate for their age. Adas Emuno's children learn about Jewish holidays, traditions and Israel in a fun and engaging setting. One highlight of religious school is our family services! They are held once a month on Friday evenings. Each grade helps lead the service along with the Rabbi.

### Grades 6-7

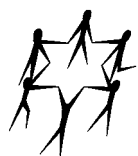
### Grades 8-10

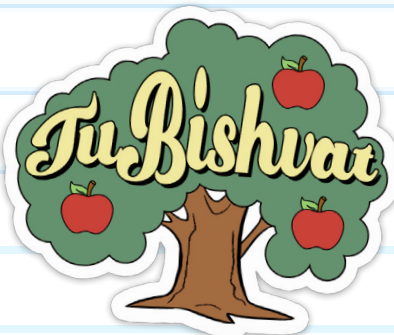
### Youth Group
